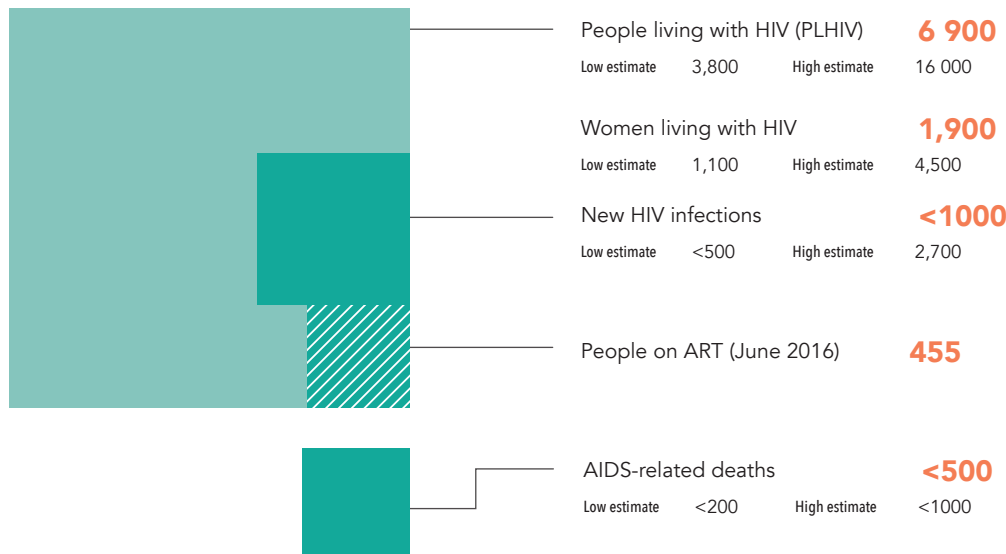

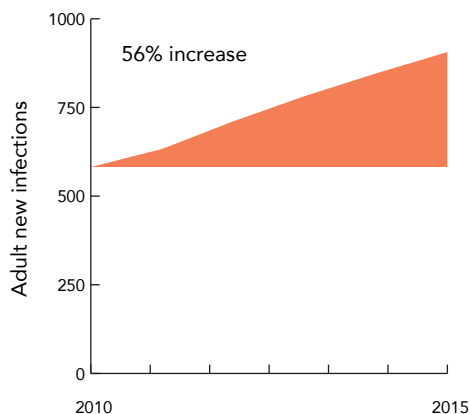

New HIV infections trend



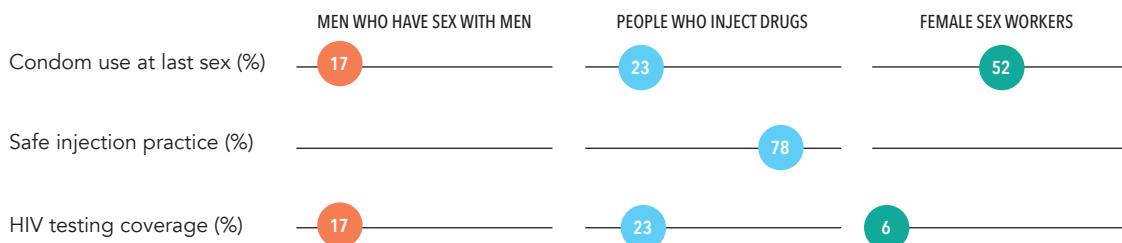

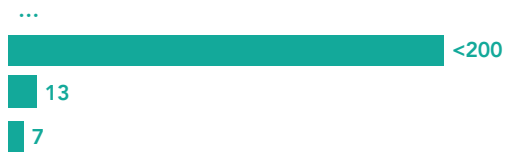
Prevention of mother-to-child transmission (PMTCT), 2015

Estimated pregnant women living with HIV

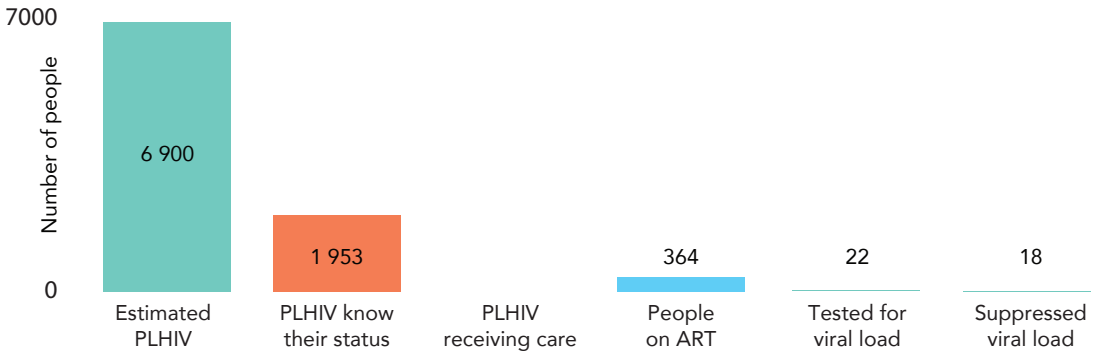
Diagnosed HIV positive pregnant women

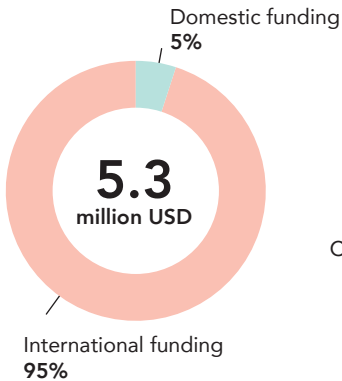
Treatment cascade, 2015



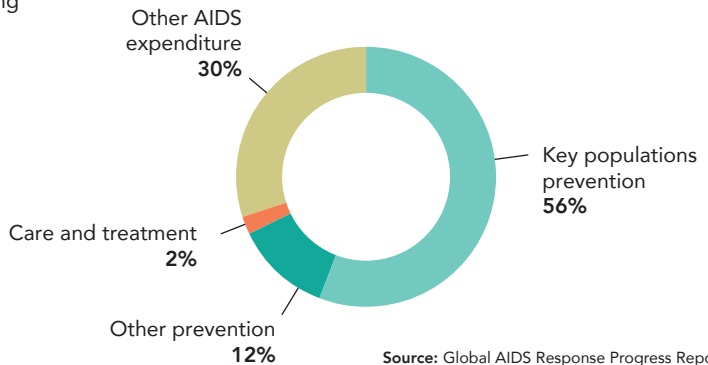
