### NEWLY DIAGNOSED CASES

In August 2022, there were 1,346 confirmed HIV-positive individuals reported to the HIV/AIDS & ART Registry of the Philippines (HARP) and were accounted to the total (104,458) reported cases since January 1984. Moreover, 368 (27%) of individuals reported in August had an advanced HIV infection<sup>c,d</sup> at the time of diagnosis. Two hundred twenty deaths were newly reported, bringing the total deaths reported this year to 541<sup>e</sup>.

Of the total reported cases this period, 1,281 (95%) were male while 65 (5%) were female. Moreover, 779 (58%) were cisgender, 49 (4%) were transgender women, 10 (<1%) identified as others, four (<1%) as neither man nor woman, one (<1%) identified as a transgender man, and 503 (37%) had unknown gender identity<sup>f</sup>.

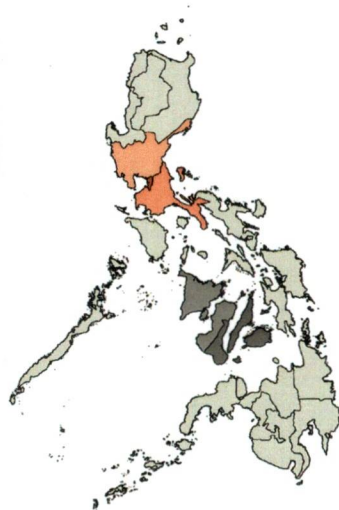
Further, 696 (52%) of the cases were 25-34 years old at the time of diagnosis, 385 (29%) were 15-24 years old, 219 (16%) were 35-49 years old, 45 (3%) were 50 years and older, and one (<1%) was less than 15 years old<sup>b</sup>. The age of the newly reported cases ranged from 8 to 76 years old (median: 28 years).

### Geographic Distribution

The regions with the most number of newly reported cases remain to be NCR, CaLaBaRZon [4A], Central Luzon [3], Central Visayas [7], and Western Visayas [6]. These regions comprised 67% of the total number of cases in this period [Figure 1]<sup>b</sup>.

### Mode of Transmission (MOT)

Of the total reported cases in August 2022, 1,323 (98%) acquired HIV through sexual contact, seven (1%) through sharing of infected needles, while 16 (1%) had no data on MOT at the time of reporting.

Among the 9,903 reported cases from January to August 2022 who acquired HIV through sexual contact, 8,771 (89%) were males who reported having sex with a male – 6,609 (67%) male - male only and 2,162 (22%) male - male and female<sup>g</sup> [Table 1].

### Anti-Retroviral Therapy (ART)

In August 2022, there were 1,062 people with HIV who were enrolled to treatment, 1,059 were on first line regimen, one was on second line regimen, and two were on other line of regimen. Among them, three (<1%) were less than 15 years old, 308 (29%) were 15-24 years old, 533 (50%) were 25-34 years old, 196 (18%) were 35-49 years old and 22 (2%) were 50 years and older. The median CD4 of these patients upon enrollment was at 205.5 cells/mm<sup>3</sup>.

A total of 64,524 people living with HIV (PLHIV) were presently on ART as of August 2022, of which, 62,095 (96%) were on the first line regimen, 1,949 (3%) were on the second line, and 480 (1%) were on the third line of regimen. The age of reported cases ranged from 1 to 80 years (median: 32 years old).

## SPECIFIC POPULATION

### Pregnant Women with HIV

In August 2022, there were eight HIV-positive pregnant women reported at the time of diagnosis. The age at diagnosis ranged from 20 to 32 years old (median: 23 years). Since 2011, a total of 689 diagnosed women was reported pregnant at the time of diagnosis.

### Overseas Filipino Workers (OFW)

Seventy-six (6%) of the total reported cases in August 2022 were Filipinos who worked overseas within the past five years, whether on land or at sea. Among them, 73 (96%) were male and three (4%) were female. All of the new HIV-positive OFWs acquired HIV through sexual contact – 44 (58%) through male-male sex, 21 (28%) through sex with both males & females<sup>l</sup>, and 11 (14%) were through male-female sex. The age of diagnosis ranged from 18 to 59 years old (median: 33 years).



### Transactional Sex

In August 2022, 134 (10%) of the newly reported cases engaged in transactional sex within the past 12 months. Majority (132, 99%) were male and the age of diagnosis ranged from 16 to 59 years old (median: 30 years). Among the male cases, 71 (54%) reported paying for sex, 45 (34%) reported accepting payment for sex, and 16 (12%) were engaged in both. Of the two females, one paid for sex and one accepted payment for sex.

### Youth (15-24 years old)

Three hundred eighty-five (29%) of the reported cases this month were among the youth aged 15-24 years old, of which, 367 (95%) were male. Eighty-three (22%) among the youth cases were reported to have advanced HIV infection<sup>k</sup>.

Of the reported youth cases, 382 (99%) acquired HIV through sexual contact (286 male-male sex, 64 through sex with both males & females<sup>l</sup>, and 32 through male-female sex). Three (1%) had no data on MOT at the time of reporting [Figure 2].

### Children (<10) & Adolescents (10-19)

In August 2022, there were 61 newly reported cases aged 19 years and below, of which, 60 were adolescents aged 10 to 19 years old, and one was a child less than 10 years old. Among the adolescent cases, 41 (68%) were 18-19 years old and 19 (32%) were 15-17 years old. Majority (59, 98%) of the reported adolescent cases acquired HIV through sexual contact (48 male-male sex, 7 through sex with both males & females<sup>l</sup>, and 4 male-female sex), while one had no data on MOT. On the other hand, one child who was 8 years old at the time of diagnosis had no data on MOT at the time of reporting.

### Mortality<sup>l,m</sup>

In August 2022, there were 220 reported deaths due to any cause among people with HIV, of which, one (<1%) was less than 15 years old at the time of death, 43 (19%) were 15-24 years old, 98 (44%) were 25-34 years old, 57 (26%) were 35-49 years old, and 21 (9%) were 50 years old and above<sup>n</sup>. More than half (111, 51%) of the newly reported deaths were from Central Visayas [7], Davao Region [11], and Northern Mindanao [10]. The rest of the country reported 109 (49%) deaths.

From January 1984 to August 2022, there were a total of 5,911 reported deaths, of which, 39 (1%) were less than 15 years old at the time of death, 1,296 (22%) were 15-24 years old, 2,848 (48%) were 25-34 years old, 1,438 (24%) were 35-49 years old, and 287 (5%) were 50 years old and older. Three (<1%) of the reported deaths had no reported age at the time of death<sup>n</sup>.

### HIV/AIDS & ART REGISTRY OF THE PHILIPPINES

The HARP is the official record of total number of diagnoses (laboratory-confirmed), ART outcome status and deaths among people with HIV in the Philippines. All individuals in the registry are confirmed by the San Lazaro Hospital STD/AIDS Cooperative Central Laboratory (SACCL) which is the HIV/AIDS National Reference Laboratory (NRL) and DOH Certified Rapid HIV Diagnostic Algorithm - HIV-1a Confirmatory Laboratories (CCLs). Confirmed HIV positive individuals were reported to the DOH-Epidemiology Bureau (EB) and recorded to HARP. ART figures are counts of HIV positive adult and pediatric patients currently enrolled and accessing Antiretroviral (ARV) medication during the reporting period in 120 treatment hubs and primary HIV care treatment facilities that had reported in the HARP. This report did not include patients who have previously taken ARV but have died, left the country, have been lost to follow-up and/or opted not to take ARV. Lost to follow-up is considered once a person have failed to visit a treatment facility more than 3 months after the expected date of ARV refill.

HARP is a passive surveillance system. Except for HIV confirmation by the NRL & CCLs, all other data submitted to the HARP are secondary and cannot be verified. Hence, HARP cannot determine if an individual's reported place of residence is where the person got infected, or where the person lived after being infected, or where the person is presently living. This limitation has major implications on data interpretation. Readers are advised to interpret the data with caution and consider other sources of information before arriving at conclusions.
