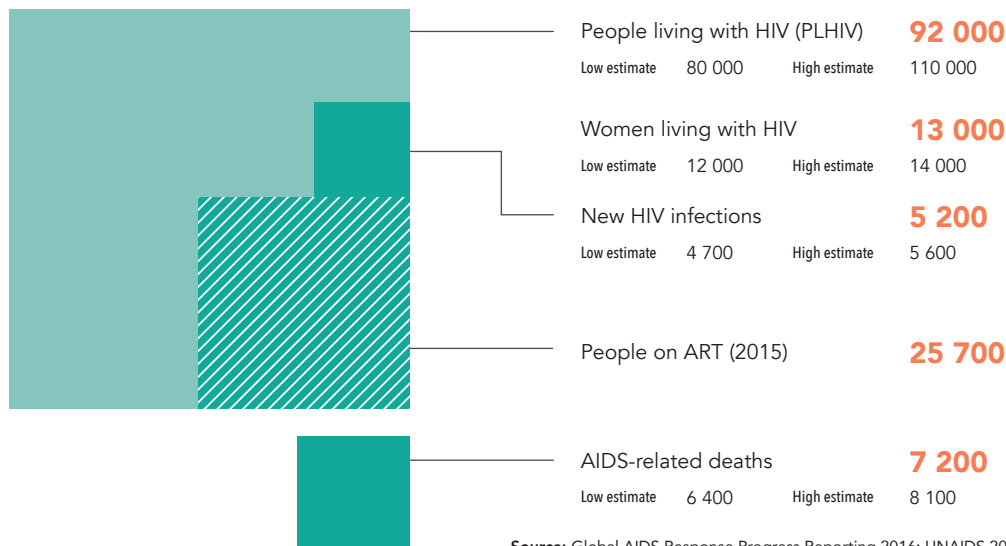




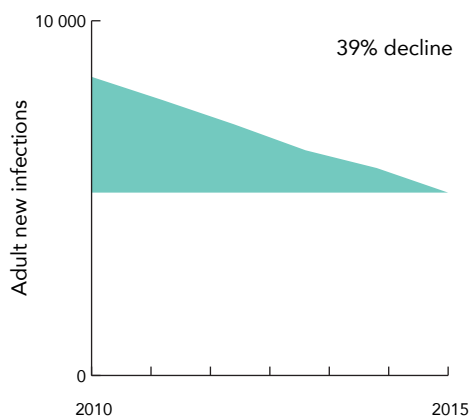

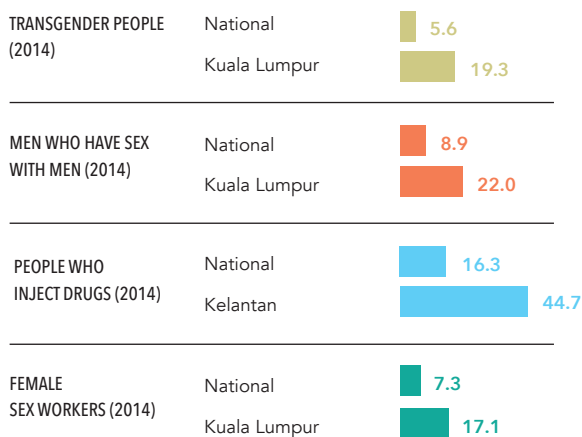

## New HIV infections trend



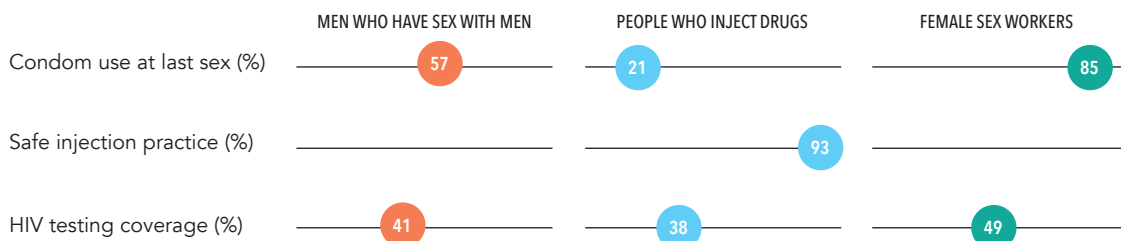

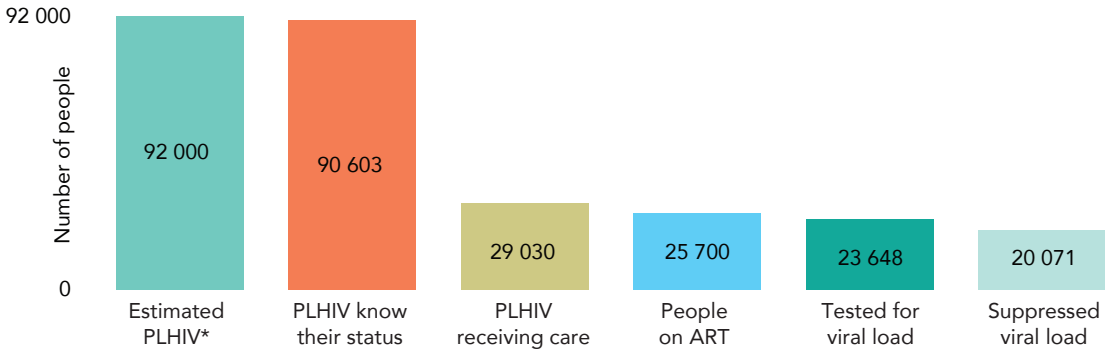

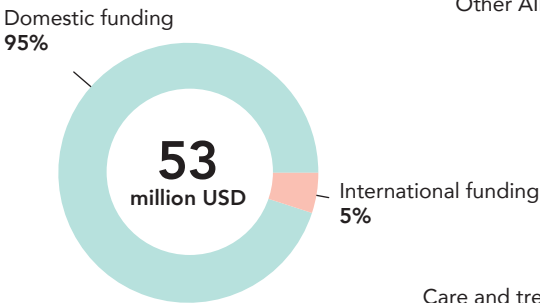
## Treatment cascade, 2015



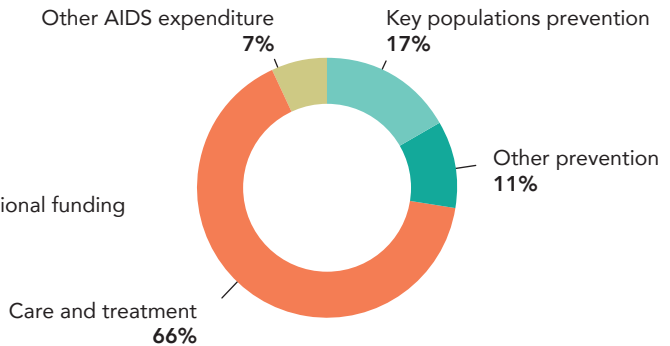
