- Goal: To reduce HIV transmission among MSM and their sexual partners in HCMC











Project description (Cont.)

- Objectives:
 - -Raise AIDS awareness among MSM
 - Increase safer sexual behaviors among MSM and their sexual partners
 - Increase access to "MSM-friendly" services for STI, VCT and HIV care and treatment











Strategic approaches

- Implementation of community peer outreach activities
- Establishment and operation of drop-in center services and activities
- Increase of access to "MSM-friendly" services for STI, VCT and HIV care and treatment through integrated and linked services
- Improvement of availability and use of condoms and water-based lubricants
- Capacity building for MSM to manage the program



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HEALTH CENTER

Community outreach activities

- Outreach activities: done by 25 peer outreach workers (POWs) and supervised by 4 health educators (HEs)
- <u>Sites</u>: cafes, road-side bars, sauna parlors, parks, streets, discotheques, cinemas, swimming pools, etc.
- <u>Contents</u>: friendship building, education and awareness, IEC materials distribution, condom and lube distribution and referrals to the drop-in center and supportive services
- Coverage to date: 17 out of 24 districts with 35 sites











Drop-in center services and activities

- Counseling services: HIV/AIDS/STIs and psychosexual health
- Information: mini-library, topic talks, IEC materials, etc.
- Referrals to integrated and linked services for VCT, STI, OI/ART, home-based care and peer support groups
- Edutainment activities

Support access services

- Survey and identify "user-friendly" clinics.
- Select "friendly" services on STI, VCT, care and treatment on HIV/AIDS for referral.
- Support training for sensitive service sites for MSM.
- Supply information on "friendly" services to peer educators.
- Organize regular meetings with referral services.





Capacity building

- Training on management and monitor project activities for club staff.
- Training on program management for project officers.
- Basic and refresher training for peer educators.















Capacity building

- Training on VCT and counselling skill for health educators and counsellors.
- Training on psychological counselling skill and sexual health for health educators and counsellors.
- Training on capacity reinforcement for PLWHAs.
- Training on sensitive matters of MSM for referral services
- Training on Clinical management guide for sexual health care of MSM and transgender people for STI doctors.

PROMOTION ACTIVITIES FOR USING CONDOM AND LUBRICANT (International DKT)

- Quarterly meeting with DKT in HCMC.
- Monitoring activities at site sales.
- Training for traditional and non-traditional site sales.
- Training on male and female condoms, lubricant for project peer educators.
- Distributing condoms and lubricants to outreach sites in HCMC.











Achievements (May 04 - Oct 05)

Indicators	Cumulative
Total number of MSM reached	<u>5,717</u>
* Number of MSM reached by outreach	4,173
* Number of MSM reached by drop-in center	1,544
Number of MSM referred to supportive services	900
Total number of IEC materials distributed	25,200
Total number of condoms distributed	39,646
Total number of lubricant sachets distributed	11,473











ADVANTAGES AND DISADVANTAGES

1. Advantages:

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- Getting technical support from HCMC PAC and FHI.
- Getting legal support from the People's Committee and HCMC PAC
- Getting agreement from local government authorities, project site unions. (Binh Thạnh Health Center)
- Active and creative staff.
- Getting active support and participation of peer educators and volunteers.



ADVANTAGES AND DISADVANTAGES (cont.)

2. Disadvantages:

- Very difficult to access the "hidden" MSM.
- Lack of sympathy for MSM in the community.



Future directions

- Expand the coverage of outreach activities
- Improve the quality of the drop-in center services & activities
- Strengthen linkages with supportive services supported by FHI and others in HCMC
- Provide training on:
 - sensitization for service providers (Aug 05)
 - clinical management guidelines for sexual health care of TG/MSM for STI physicians (Nov 05)
 - psychosexual counseling for HEs/counselors (Nov 05)











Future directions (cont.)

- Provide training and mentoring for the staff of MSM interventions supported by FHI and others in the country
- Evaluate the effectiveness of the MSM intervention in HCMC to highlight lessons learned for scaling-up
