




Trend of ever enrolled vs currently on ART






Trend of PLHIV currently on ART






Trend of new PLHIV on ART






Trend of new PLHIV on ART






PMTCT testing vs positivity (Jan-June 2020)






Trend of PMTCT testing vs positivity






Trend of PMTCT testing vs positivity






Early Infant Diagnosis (EID)




Total EID testing vs positivity (Jan-June 2020)






Trend of EID testing vs positivity






Trend of EID testing vs positivity






Trend of EID testing vs positivity






Total EID testing within 2 months vs positivity (Jan-June 2020)






Trend of EID testing within 2 months vs positivity






Trend of EID testing within 2 months vs positivity

Efforts made to ensure incessant delivery of HIV-related services during COVID-19 pandemic



Efforts Made

- NCASC develop and disseminated 2020 HIV Testing and Treatment Guidelines in May 2020.
 - New guidelines introduces Dolutegravir (DTG) as the first line drugs for all and advocates on rapid initiation of ART.
- Ensure effective implementation of DTG based regimen in Nepal:
 - NCASC conducted a virtual orientation on the use of DTG-based regimen to all the health care provider's working at ART sites in all seven provinces
- NCASC has also supplied DTG based regimen to all ART sites despite COVID-19 pandemic situation



Efforts Made

- NCASC with collaboration with community organizations and other partners ensured home delivery for uninterrupted ARVs in times of COVID-19.
- PWID received OST service at home during the government imposed nationwide shelter in place.
- PPE provided to the health workers working against HIV response in different service delivery points in Nepal.
